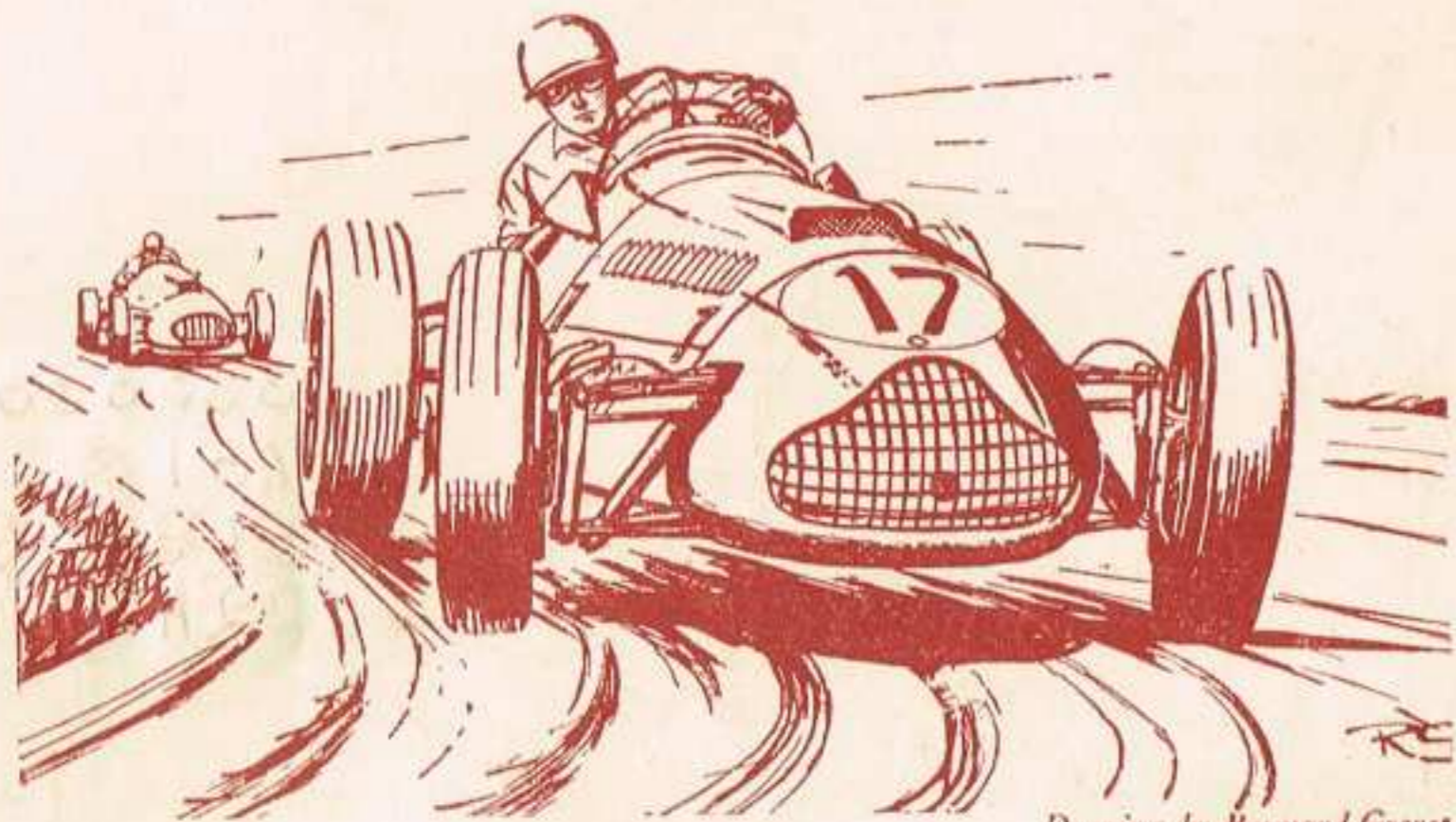

## FLAG SIGNALS

Official signals to the drivers are given by means of flags which have an internationally agreed meaning. The key is as follows:

<b>Union Jack</b> ... ..	Used for Start of Race.
<b>Red Flag</b> ... ..	Stop immediately.
<b>Yellow</b> ... ..	Waved, great danger, be prepared to stop. Held stationary, take care.
<b>Blue</b> ... ..	Waved, someone is trying to pass you. Held stationary, someone is just behind you.
<b>Yellow with Red Stripes</b> ...	Oil on the Course.
<b>Black (with No.)</b> ... ..	Car of number shown, stop at pit.
<b>White</b> ... ..	Service Car or ambulance on Course.
<b>Black and White Check</b> ... ..	Race over.

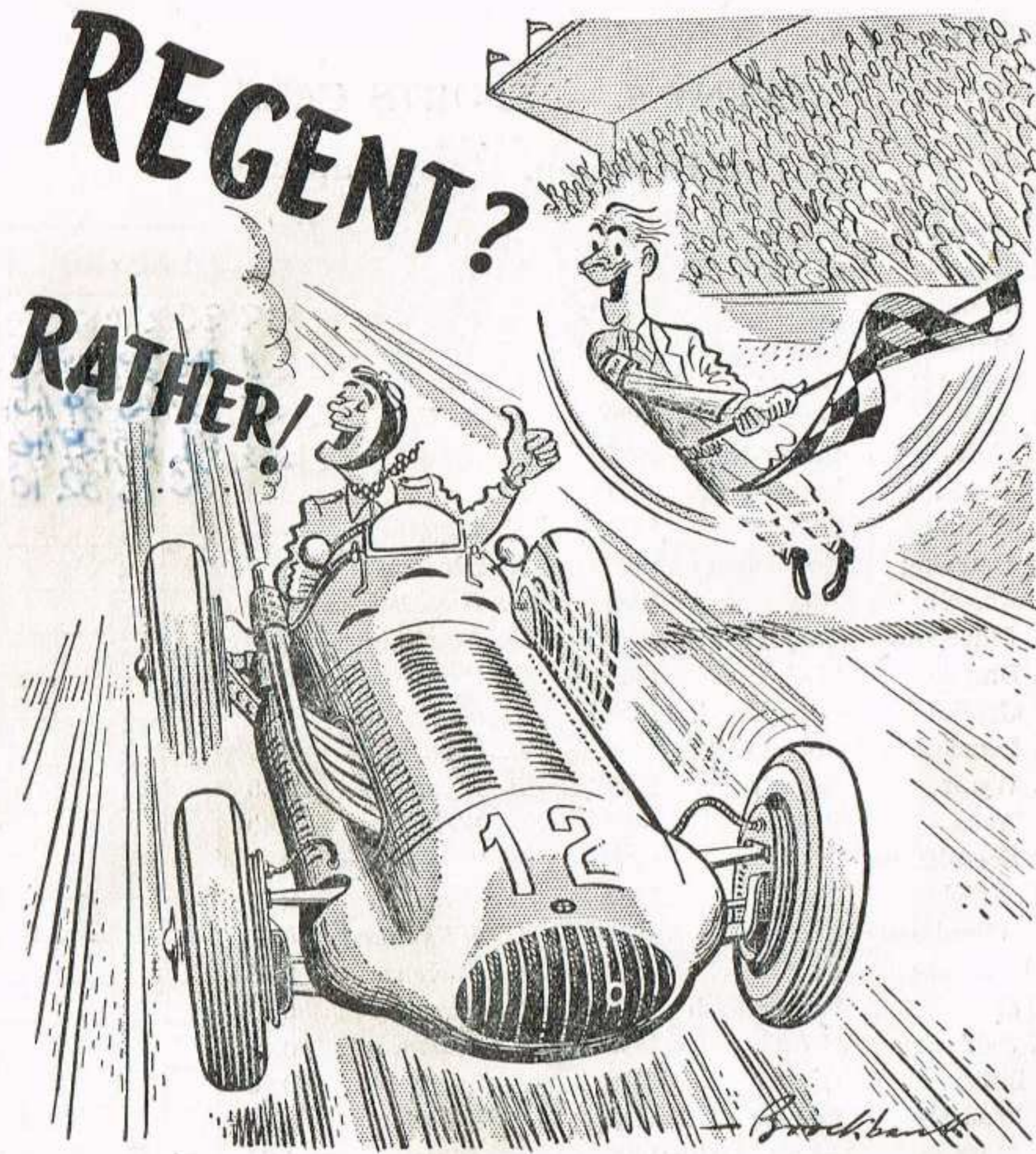

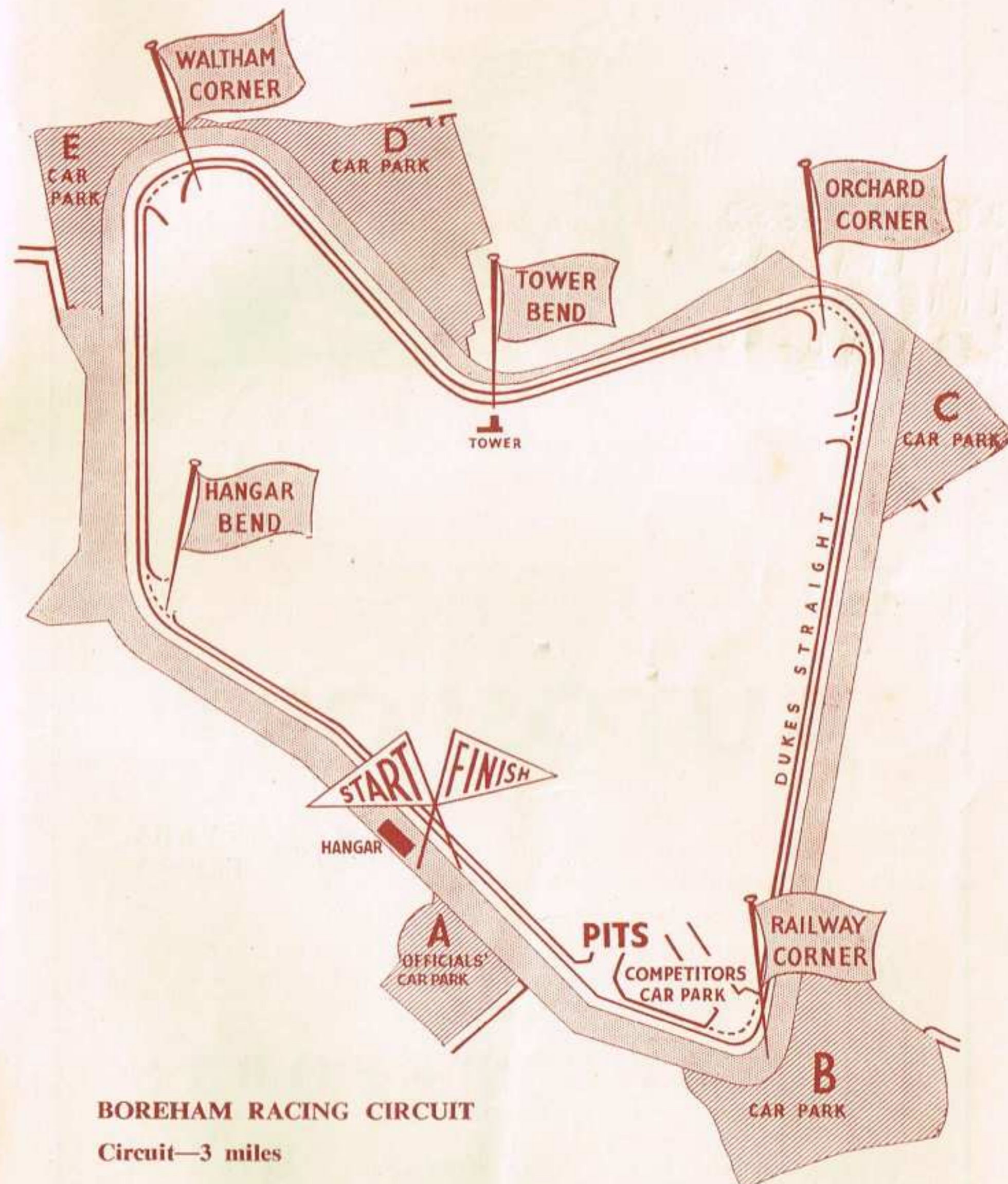
