

A Thrilling Chapter

WITH this meeting the curtain comes down on the first season of the new Boreham motor-racing circuit. What a year it has been!—from the exciting motorcycle meeting on April 26, when Robin Sherry captured the track record and showed the brilliance which later earned him promotion to A.J.S. works rider, down to the recent August Bank Holiday "Daily Mail" International Festival of Motor Sport.

The year's meetings have opened a Boreham chapter in the history of motor sport. Deeds and duels, startling speeds and courageous feats of endurance, as well as the general level of unaffectedly good motor racing, have written their own record and earned "full marks" for the circuit.

The pioneers of the circuit are the Chelmsford and District Auto Club who organise to-day's meeting. When the circuit was just a newly unemployed airfield—in September, 1950—with the permission of the owners, Co-Partnership Farms and their enterprising General Manager, Mr. E. N. Boswell, they laid out the course with stakes, ropes and straw bales and ran the first motorcycle meeting. They gave the names to the bends and corners that are now famous.

Motorcycle racing had the honour of beginning this year with the April 26 meeting.

On July 26 the Club organised a National meeting second to none held on the mainland of this country since the war. Records were made—among them Ken Kavanagh's remarkable achievement on a 499 c.c. Norton, lapping at 95.24 m.p.h.

The Bank Holiday International Festival included a grand motorcycle event on the Monday with great riding in heavy rain.

The year's events have brought scores of thousands of enthusiasts to Boreham. And many of them came for the first time. It is hoped that they took away with them pleasant, as well as exciting, memories.

Boreham is on the map. And when to-day's races end, the riders, the drivers and the spectators who have witnessed the circuit's rise to fame may look forward to a more spectacular year still in 1953.



BOREHAM RACING CIRCUIT




