2). It will not, in future, (except for the Grand Prix) be possible to book isolated seats in various parts of the stands concerned. Instead all advance bookings will be concentrated in a single reserved area offering particularly good viewing.

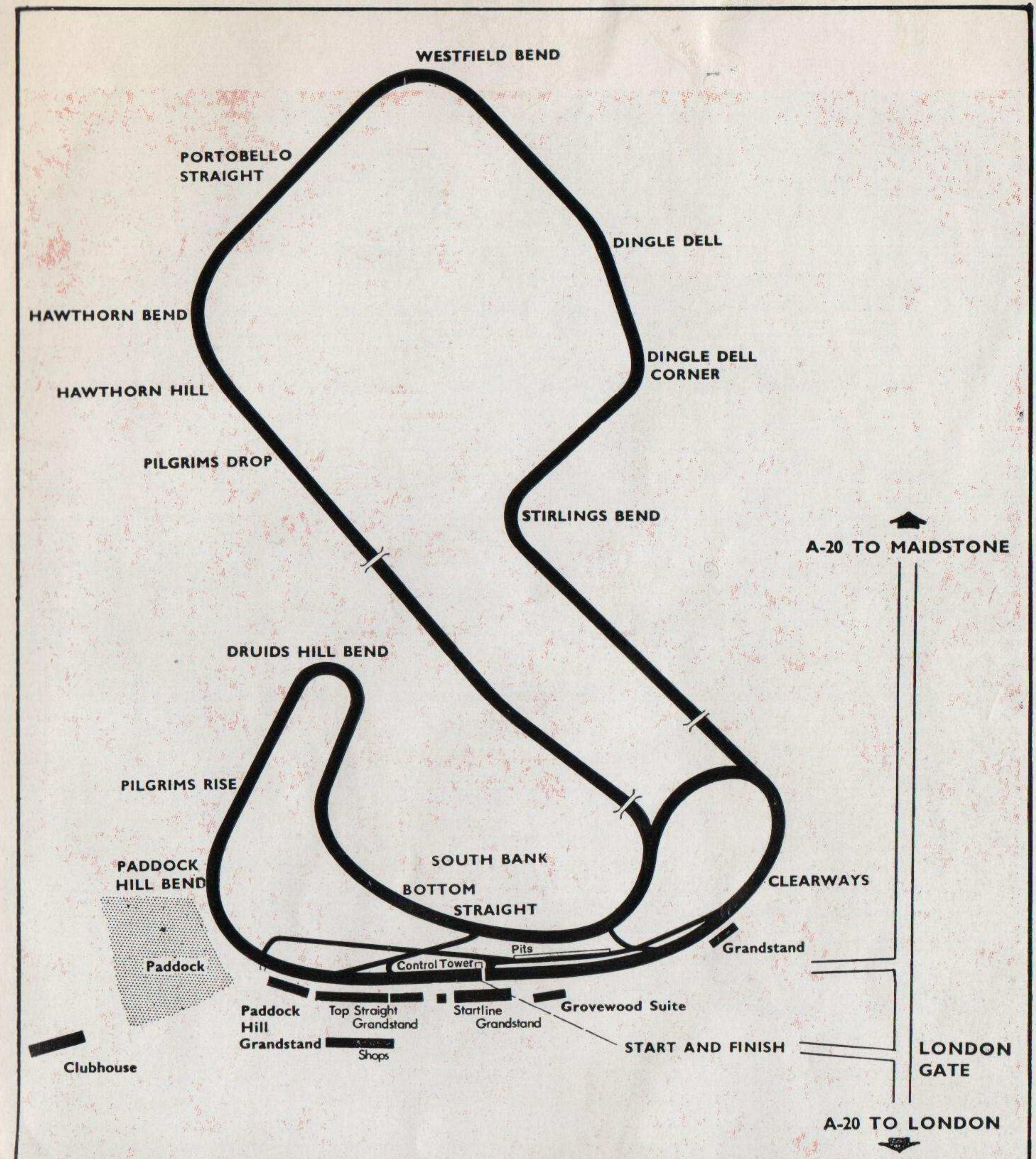

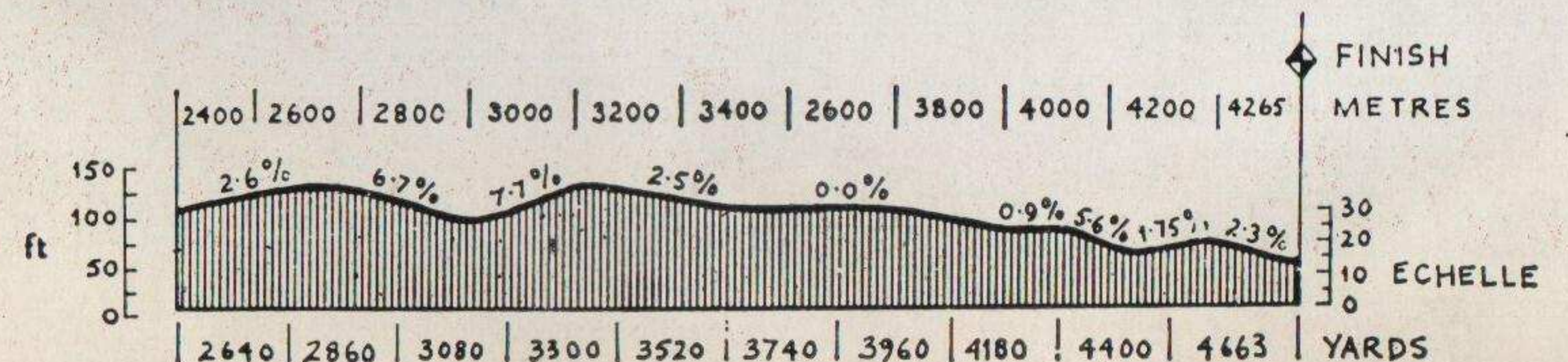
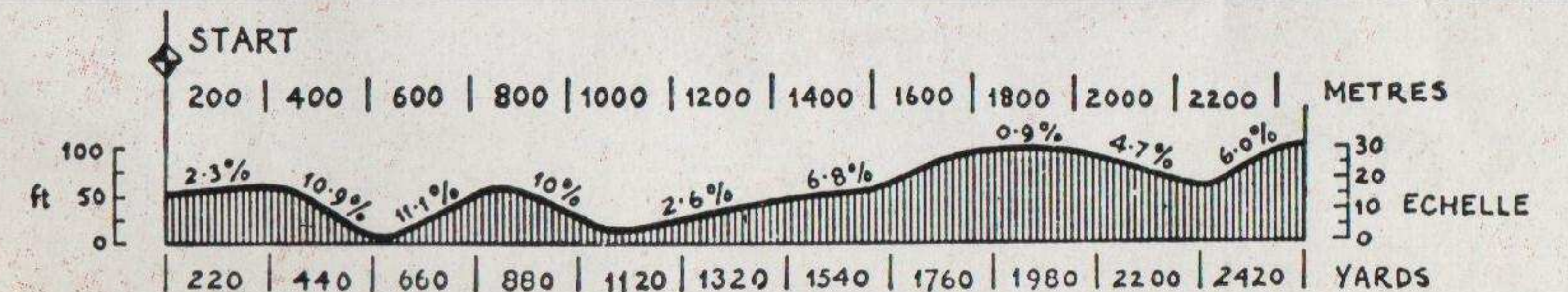
