





Mighty 400 horse-power Ford GT.40's and Lola T.70's ... snarling Porsches and Ferraris and fleet streamlined Lotus Europas, Chevrons, Ginettas and Nathans ... these are some of the cars which will make up the 10,000 horse-power entry for the last round of the RAC British Sports Car Championship—the famous Guards International—at Brands Hatch Grand Prix Circuit, Kent on Bank Holiday Monday, September 2.
