

WELCOME TO DEBDEN

It is not often that we have the pleasure of welcoming the public to one of our Sprints, but today thanks to the generosity of the Officer Commanding this airfield we are afforded that privilege, I need hardly remind you that he will expect you to leave the area as 'spic and span' as you found it, and that is the very least that we can do to show our appreciation of his kindness.

Today's meeting is the last of the 1965 season, and the entry is the largest ever to contend a sprint in Great Britain, several of the riders you will see in action today will be rounding off their seasons efforts next week-end in an attempt to both establish and break World records.

Among these, in the 250 cc. class will be young Anthony Brown No. 49, he will be opposed today by two up and coming men in No. 17 D. Heckle and No. 27. T. Measures. The 350 c.c. class will see some fireworks with a clash between No. 150 Eamon Hurley, the class champion, and No. 53. A. Charalambos the recent Sunbeam event winner, No. 56. David Leqoc will however be out to upset both of these, and watching for the slightest mistake will be No. 59 B. Scammel on his Velocette. The very exciting 500 c.c. class will see the fantastic Freddie Cooper No. 85 in action again opposed by Arthur Breese No. 86, and Freddie has a Ramsgate defeat to avenge. Unfortunately the British Record Holder in this class Jack Terry will be too occupied with the organisation of this event to compete himself, but one to watch will be Bill Orris No. 88 on his wonderful Rudge, and we must not forget the claims of No. 73 Phil Manzano the Brighton class winner.

In the 750 c.c. class No. 149 Martin Roberts the British record holder will be all out to demonstrate his superiority over No. 148 Pete Smith who will be riding the ex.

Hagon record breaker, a welcome return to Bill Bragg probably the most popular man on the strip, Bill is No. 127 but I have a feeling they are going a bit too fast for Bill this season, No. 134 Denis Jenkinson, co-partner to Stirling Moss is also a man to watch, and don't forget to give a reception to my good friend but nevertheless that old rascal Ken Weekes No. 141, Ken will be riding a newly prepared 700 c.c. supercharged Enfield, whether this will ever go 'bang' is anybody's guess, but whatever happens you can be sure that Ken will have an answer for it.

The 1000 c.c. event will be unique in that you will see World Record Holder George Brown No. 165 on Super Nero oppose his son Anthony No. 164 on Nero knowing George there will be no holds barred here, but watching them both will be No. 151 Ian Ashwell the victor of Ramsgate and Brighton who will be all out to consolidate his position in this class.

The battle of the 'monsters' should be worth travelling miles to see, No. 170 Alf Hagon currently the fastest man in the country will be all out to break the 10 second barrier and so become the first man in Great Britain to do so, you will also see that 'Prince' of sprinters Howard German on the fabulous Dragwaye machine No. 166, also in the class will be No. 168 D. Page and No. 153 J. Camhi, entered also is veteran Ernie Woods on a fiercesome supercharged Norton on Jap crankcases.

Among the sidecars you will see the famous Maurice Brierley on Methanon, and No. 176 Fred Booth who will be attempting records next week, and No. 175 P. Dodd. Also entered in this class is Les Bolton who has the legendary 'Bob Berry' world record attempt engine installed in his L.V.S. threewheeler.

In addition to the more serious events there is a competition for the Press and Officials and if their performances of last year are anything to go by this should be worth watching. I could not complete these notes without asking you to join with me in a vote of thanks to all the helpers who are responsible for putting on this meeting, all of them unpaid, and without whose assistance there would be no meeting, please help to make their task easy, I wish all of you a good day's sport, and may the best men win.
