## RULES

- The competition is open to all members of the B.W.R.D.C.
- Results will be computed on a points basis over the nominated meetings.
- Each entrant to count only the best six meetings.
- Only one race at any one meeting may count, but if competing in more than one race, the better result may be claimed.
- Results of all meetings raced must be submitted to the Secretary before the last meeting is held.
- To earn points a driver must (a) enter, (b) be accepted by the organizers of the meeting, (c) run in any race which she and her car are eligible, excluding ladies-only races or classes.
- If only one entrant competes at one of these meetings, the individual meeting award will only be allotted if the competitor finishes in either first six or first half of her class, (i.e. half the number of entrants listed in the programme).
- Should a competitor have already been awarded a brooch, she may request an alternative award, (this to be chosen by W. D. & H. O. Wills).
- Points:
  - 1 for starting
  - plus 1 for finishing
  - plus 9 for first place
  - 6 for second place
  - 4 for third place
  - 3 for fourth place
  - 2 for fifth place
  - 1 for sixth place.
- A class position to count in the same manner as a race position.
- Ties
  - 1st place—the driver with the greatest number of high positions shall be awarded the First Prize.
  - 2nd place—the total prize money for the Second and Third places shall be equally shared.
  - Individual meeting prize—the best race time to win.

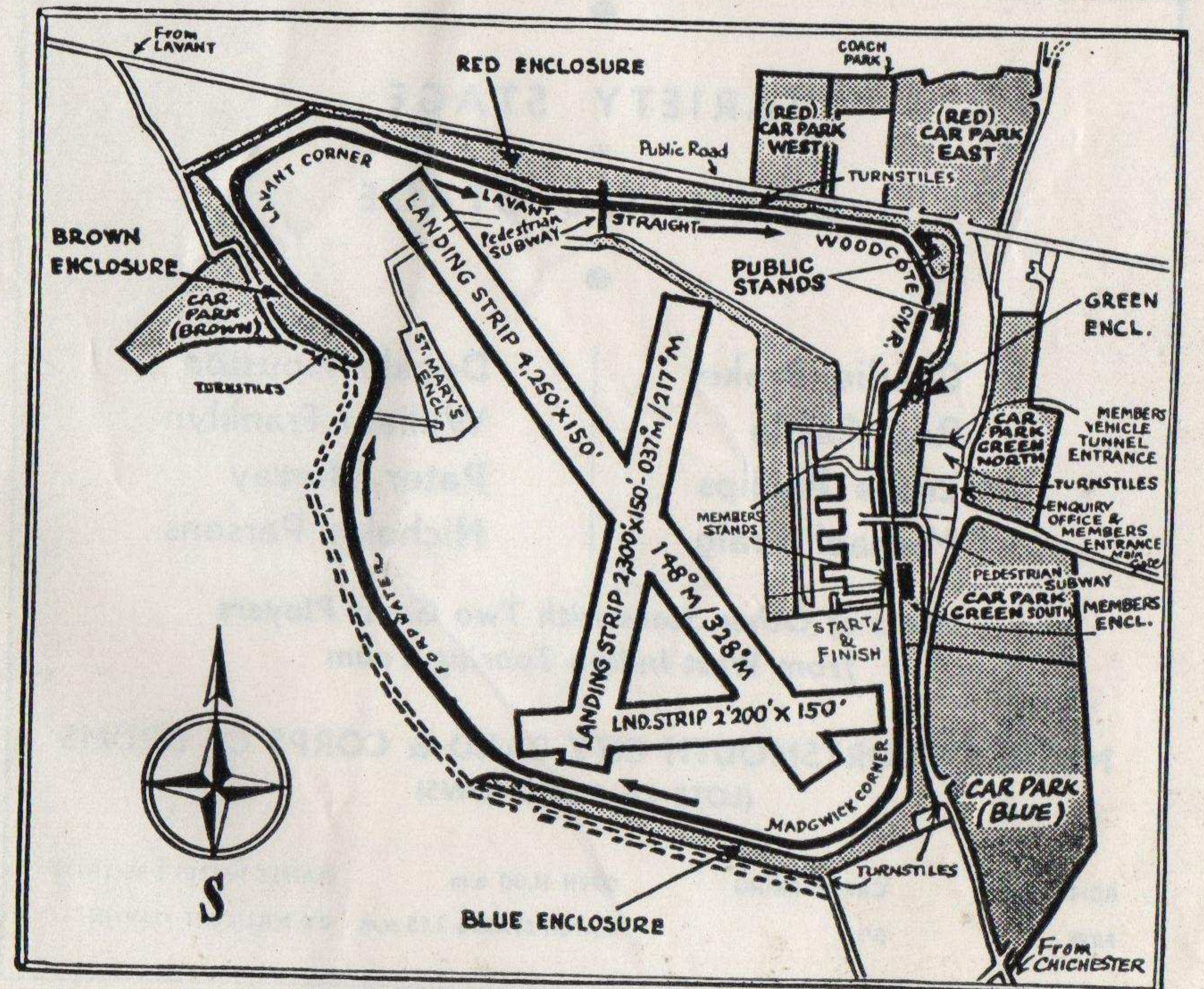
