Lakeside Speedway Hosts The Best . . .

They've all raced at Lakeside Speedway—all those great drivers who own victories in the Indianapolis 500.

A.J. Foyt, Johnny Rutherford, Al and Bobby Unser and Mario Andretti have won more Indy 500 races among them than most of us will ever see.

And all have tested the half-mile dirt track at Lakeside Speedway. To a man, they all had better luck at Indy.

There have been seven United States Auto Club sprint car races at Lakeside Speedway with as many winners. And the winners are not without credentials.

Maurice Muchnick owned and operated Lakeside Speedway for the first five USAC spring car races.

The first occurred on Sept. 1, 1963. In the field that night were A.J. Foyt, Roger McCluskey and Jim Hurtubise among others.

But the feature winner was Don Branson, a legend in the dirt track sprint car ranks. Foyt finished second and McCluskey third. It was one of 28 victories credited to Branson during his career.

The late Jerry Weld participated in the feature but did not place in the top 10.

Two years slipped by before USAC's Thunder and Lighting division returned to Lakeside Speedway.

Local hero Jud Larson was in the field for this event. Larson was returning to racing after sitting out two seasons for what at the time was believed to have been a heart attack.

Greg Weld, in his USAC rookie season, also was in the field and set fast time at 22.88 seconds.

Rutherford was there; Bobby Unser, too. So was Carl Williams, another Kansas City favorite.

Weld tried a little too hard in front of the home folks and crashed into Rutherford in the No. 1 turn early in the race.

Larson, who gave true meaning to the racing term of charger, won the feature pulling away from the field by driving the lowest groove possible on a track that had become extremely dry-slick. The pit crew had purposely set up the racer to race low because single-file conditions were predicted for a track that became dry-slick. Larson's usual style was the highest groove possible, and that was often against or touching the fence.

Jerry Daniels finished second to Larson, Williams was third, Branson fourth and Bobby Unser fifth.

Another all-star field materialized for a July 15 race in 1966. There were 34 sprint cars in the pits. Bobby Unser set fast time in 22.06 seconds—faster than laps turned in by Andretti, McCluskey, Branson and brother Al, who made a rare sprint car appearance.

But it wasn't a night for the stars.

Arnie Knepper, made the move of the night on another dry-slick track and finished in front of Bobby Unser, Andretti and Branson.

About halfway through the race Knepper was in third place behind Wib Spaulding and Jerry Daniels. Passing was difficult but possible. Instead of picking off No. 2 and then No. 1, Knepper went extremely high in the No. 3 turn, cut sharply inside coming out of the fourth turn and passed Spaulding and Daniels before reaching the flagman.

Greg Weld made a triumphant homecoming on July 7, 1967, the season he won eight feature races of his career total 21 and won the USAC championship.

Weld took the lead at the start and was never threatened. Rollie Beale finished second, Chuck Booth third and Mike Mosley fourth. George Snider, Bobby Unser and Rutherford finished back in the pack.

Hometown drivers made it two in a row as Williams won on July 5, 1968 in the closet and most exciting of the USAC races at Lakeside.

Williams immediately took the lead and held it all the way. But at no time in the 40-lap distance was Snider's sprint car more than 3 feet from Williams' racer.

Snider tried to pass high and low in every corner and on both straights. Williams was up to every driving trick. Snider got a well deserved second and Larry Dickson was a distant third. Gerry Bettenhausen finished fourth and Greg Weld was fifth.

On July 8, 1978 the next USAC sprint car race was held at Lakeside and this time Greg Weld was the promoter.

Weld held out for some temporary drivers and USAC relented.

Among the "temps" was Doug Wolfgang, then and now a star on the World of Outlaws circuit.

Wolfie did a number on the USAC regulars and only a thunder shower could stop Wolfgang.

He surged to a three car-length lead after one lap and was slightly more than half a lap in the lead when rain stopped the event after 27 laps. Roger Rager was second, Billy Cassella third and Chuck Gurney fourth.

It was Wolfgang's first USAC race. He later was to win his first USAC champ dirt car race and his first USAC midget feature.

On June 5, 1981 the USAC cast returned again. This time Smokey Snellbaker was the first to the checkered flag in rather easy fashion with Rich Vogler second, Eddie Leavitt third and Gary Bettenhausen, driving promoter Joe Booth's racer, fourth. It was Snellbaker's first USAC victory.

Leavitt set fast time in 21.79 seconds in what is believed to be the fastest lap at Lakeside in a sprint car without wings.

In fact, all USAC track records at Lakeside were set that night as Joe Saldana set the 8-lap mark, and Snellbaker set standards at 10 laps and 30 laps.

And the records came despite near dreadful conditions. The track was over-watered in anticipation of a hot, sunny afternoon. But clouds moved in and the races never got underway until almost 11 p.m.

Lakeside Speedway also was the site of three USAC midget races, and like the "big-car" drivers, Mel Kenyon, the greatest of them all, had no success on the track.

On Sept. 17, 1976, Sleepy Tripp, his championship season, won his 10th and final feature of the season. Gene Gennetten was second, Dana Carter third, Jim McElreath fourth and Rich Vogler fifth.

On June 10, 1978, Jeff Heywood won the midget feature, his first ever on the USAC circuit. Bob Wente was second, Vogler third and Larry Rice fourth.

The last USAC race at Lakeside was a midget race on Aug. 1, 1981, a race that was rained out the previous night. Johnny Parsons was the winner, Steve Lotshaw second and Kenyon had his best finish ever at the track, third. Gennetten set a midget record in the time trials with a 22.557 clocking.

Why NASCAR?

Lakeside Speedway is having NASCAR sanctioned late model stock car races because it's good for racing.

NASCAR sanctioned short-track races primarily reduce the cost to the car owner and thus creates an atmosphere for a reduced over-all operation. The car owner also will know well in advance the weekly purse for the entire season.

"All this was brought about by the unlimited race cars," said John Jones, one of the track operators who has signed Lakeside Speedway to a 3-year agreement with NASCAR and the NASCAR Winston Racing Series.

"There are a few people in every area who have the money and sponsors to put \$30,000 into a race car, but there just aren't enough tracks that can offer them the \$30,000 purse they feel they need to run their cars," Jones added.

NASCAR offers weight, body configuration rules and carburetor restrictions that make for a less expensive cost to the late model stock car owner. There also are restrictions on tires and wheels.

The NASCAR rules are designed to promote uniformity in stock cars and to give local car owners and drivers as much chance as possible against nationally known drivers who might race at Lakeside Speedway, and to give local drivers the same chance while traveling and competing at other NASCAR regions.

R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Co., a sponsor of this NASCAR Winston Racing Series for more than 10 years, will sponsor a Lakeside Speedway point fund, a regional track point fund and a national point fund.

Lakeside Speedway is one of 13 race tracks in the NASCAR Winston Racing Series Central Region.

The others are: Adams County Speedway, Corning, Iowa; Boone Speedway, Boone, Iowa; Capital Speedway, Holts Summit, Missouri; Dubuque Speedway, Dubuque, Iowa; Farley Speedway, Farley, Iowa; Hawkeye Downs Speedway, Cedar Rapids, Iowa; Kirksville Speedway, Kirksville, Missouri; Quincy Raceway, Quincy, Illinois; Rockford Speedway, Rockford, Illinois; Seven Flags Speedway, Albuquerque, New Mexico; Sunset Speedway, Omaha, Nebraska, and Thirty-four Speedway, Burlington, Iowa.

Roger Dolan of Lisbon, Iowa, won the Central Region championship in 1983.

There are four other NASCAR Winston Racing Series short-track regions - Southeast, Northeast, Mid-Atlantic and Pacific Coast.

The NASCAR Winston Racing Series offers uniformity, competition and national identification.

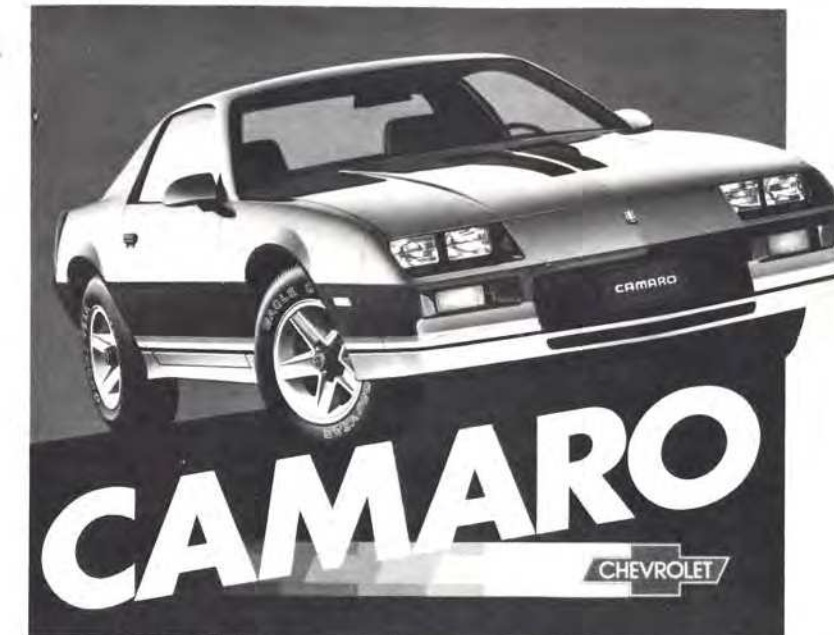

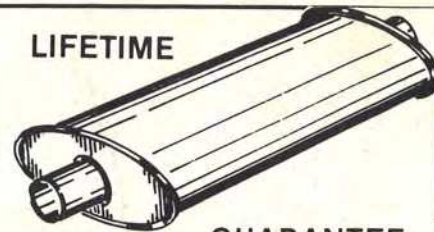
