Giddy-up, races back on

FOR the Liverpool community who love horse-racing all roads lead to the entrance gates at Warwick Farm this Saturday.

It's the AJC's first race meeting since the farm's major track revamp. To mark the return, racegoers will get in free. The feature race is the time-honoured Warwick Stakes (1400 metres).

However, it's disappointing only five runners are among the early nominations for the race. Nominations close tomorrow, Thursday, at 10am.

So far, no Warwick Farm trainers have entered runners in the race but the big names of the Warwick Farm fraternity – Guy Walter, Peter Snowden, Gary Portelli and Clarry Conners – do have runners in other races on the nine-event program.

Meanwhile, racegoers can look forward to free admission at other midweek meetings at Warwick Farm. And I reckon the AJC should go further with their future plans for revitalising racing in the Liverpool area. I want to see the AJC stage a Melbourne Cup Day picnicstyle meeting on the first Tuesday in November from next year onwards. They could host a seven-event race program, throw the gates open for free and encourage businesses and companies to hold Melbourne Cup lunches and functions on the lawns in the picnic style surroundings. I believe this cup day event could be a winner and a real boon for the area. Punters could watch the action live from Melbourne on the big screens and bet on the cup and also the live races at the farm.

THE grand finals of the first division age groups in the Southern Districts Soccer Football Association will be played this Saturday at Marconi Stadium from 8.30am. All the best to the many Liverpool clubs in the association who will compete in these finals.
