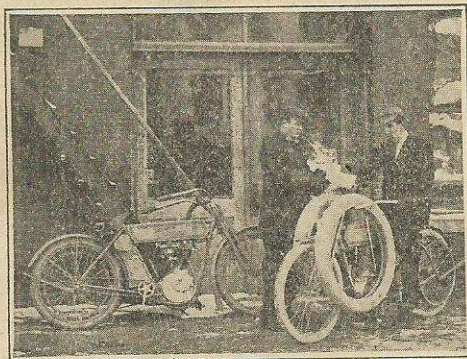

Chalmers "30" Still the Light Stock

Car Champion of America

In the Vanderbilt races of 1909 the Chalmers "30" won the Massapequa Trophy by going 129 miles in 126 minutes without a single stop.

This is an average speed of 58.5 miles an hour and is the world's record for light stock cars in a road race. (Cars in the 161-230 piston displacement class.)

This record was made nearly two years ago, and, although there have been many road races since—the latest being the Elgin Race last month—the winner of none of them has been able to come close to the record of the Chalmers "30."

At the time most of these records were world's marks, but they have since been bettered. These State Fair track records made by De Palma are:

One Mile—48.92-100dths seconds

Two Miles—1 min. 40.55-100dths seconds

Three Miles—2 min. 35.55-100dths seconds

Four Miles—3 min. 2.27-100dths seconds

Five Miles—4 min. 11.90-100dths seconds

Ten Miles—8 min. 50.70-100dths seconds

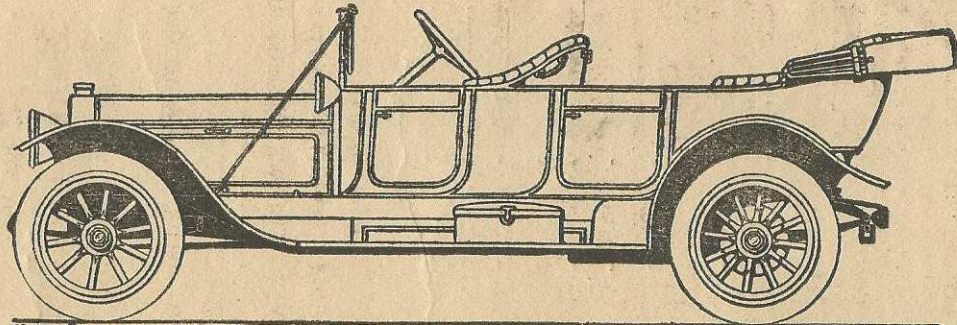
