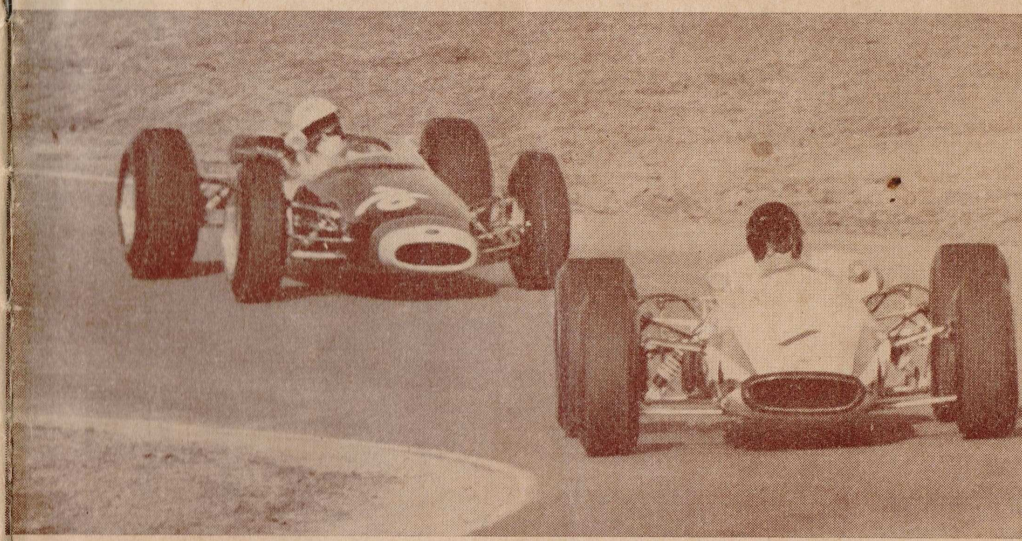

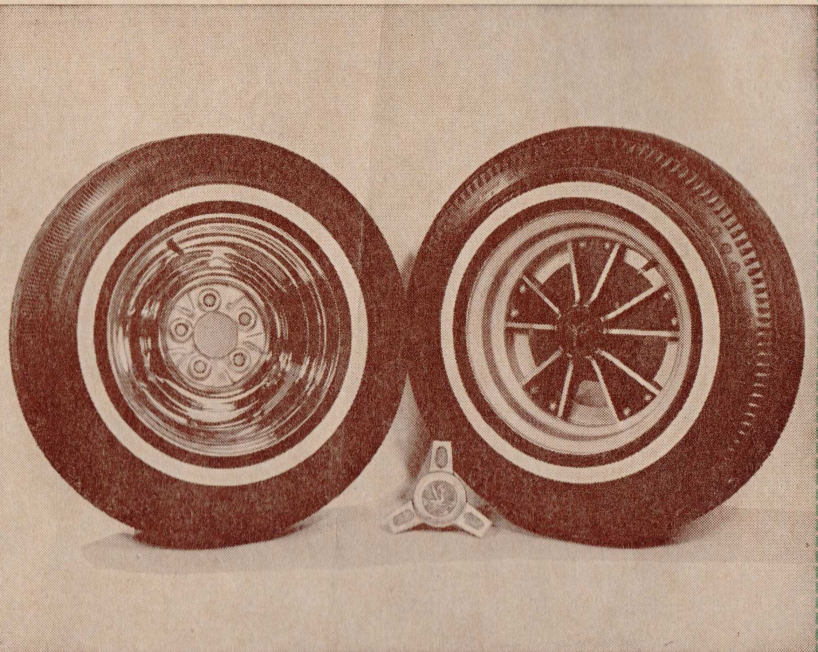

TRACK TALK

WELCOME again to Oran Park. Today's meeting is the last day-time meeting we will be having this year—but remember there will be more night racing on Saturday, December 10th.

Of the nineteen races in today's programme, four are "feature" events—one each for Holdens and Minis of all types, and one for Racing cars and one for Sports cars.

The Sports Car race, the central event of the day, is to be run over twelve laps. It is hard to look past Niel Allen for the winner. He will be racing the Elfin Oldsmobile at Oran Park for the first time, and there are very few cars likely to stay close to him.

The Elfin Type 400 design is one of the most advanced in the world, and this particular car, the first completed, has already had many successes when owned by Laurie O'Neill and driven by Frank Matich. The car is powered by a well-modified Oldsmobile V8 built up by the American firm Traco, who have also supplied many engines to Bruce McLaren for his sports cars. This engine is relatively light for the 350-plus horsepower it produces, and as the whole car is very light, thanks to many ingenious ideas which Elfin have incorporated. For example, the nose panelling, the seats and the petrol tank are all designed to add to the strength of the chassis.

There are two other Elfin sports cars in this event. One of them is very familiar to Oran Park regulars, being the light-green Clubman raced by Ray Carey. This is a very sweet-handling little car which has been very reliable, although never quite as fast as the fastest Lotus Super Sevens. The other Elfin is Ray Strong's, a beautiful rear-engined car powered by a much modified Consul engine driving through a VW transmission. Ray Strong, incidentally, used to race the Herald special which was built round a Nota chassis many years ago which first brought Spencer Martin into the limelight. This car still races, driven by Kevin Hammond.

Of the "club"-type cars which will compete in the main event, the two Lotus Super Sevens of Syd Howard and Alex MacArthur are particularly interesting. Syd's car has many special features, such as special wide magnesium wheels and rear axle to make it "the best," and Alex MacArthur's is the one with which he has won this year's Geoghegan Motors trophy series, in his first year of motor racing.

Other notable sports cars include Dennis Geary's Lotus 23B, one of the very latest of this type, having really wide wheels and a 1600cc twin-cam Ford engine. Another Lotus 23 is Les Howard's 1100cc car, which is fitted with the special down-draught Howard alloy head, which was designed by the Howard & Sons chief mechanic Geoff Smedley and which is a great improvement on the normal Ford arrangement.

There are of course many sports cars which are not the latest factory jobs. Amongst these, watch Ian Hopkins, who has designed his Ford special himself, and Peter Wallace, whose Barracuda Ford V-8 was first raced in 1935, appeared after the war as well with a Hudson engine and canvas single-seat body, and now is driven on the road, with its pre-war bodywork and a Custom-line engine.

Not to forget the Production Sports cars. Leading names here are Ross Bond and Bob Skelton, both with Austin Healeys. Ross' is the big six-cylinder 3000 and Bob's the nippier and lighter Sprite with which he has set records at nearly every N.S.W. circuit this year.

The other 12-lap race will be for Formula Vees. Every Vee but one in the State has entered. Despite the rules of the Formula, which is aimed at keeping all cars as close as possible in performance, there is great variety in the shape of Vees. Many of the owners could not have started racing without the cheap Formula which Vees offer, and as more drivers learn the black art of tuning a standard VW engine the racing will get closer and closer. The N.S.W. Formula Vee Association actively helps its members to improve their cars, and it is really surprising to see how fast a simple Vee can go with a maximum of less than 40 horsepower.

During the day there will be two races for one make of car—one race for the Minis, and one race for Holdens.

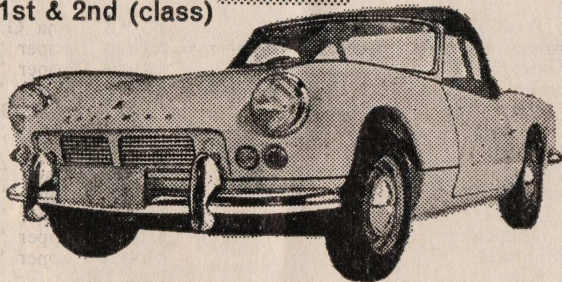

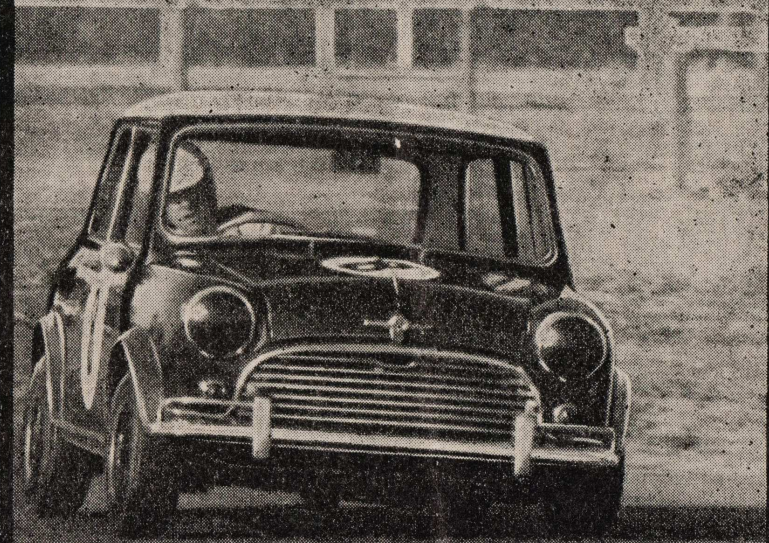

The Mini race should be a comfortable win for Don Holland in the delightful lightweight Cooper S. This is the car Brian Foley made famous, and it will run in a race sponsored by Brian Foley Motors at Caringbah, but Brian himself will be racing his own Cooper S at Sandown. The lightweight Cooper is so much modified that it is entered as a Sports Racing (closed) car—it has lost so many standard items of equipment, been drilled with so many holes, and fitted with so many go-faster items that it only **looks** like a Mini.

We welcome to Oran Park that marvellous driver and entertainer from Queensland, John French. He is seen too seldom in N.S.W., but his 1310cc Cooper S ought to give him a chance to perform at his best. We will be lucky to see him matched against the best Improved Production Cooper drivers from this State, and Bob Beasley and Phil Barnes could have a lot of fun with Talented John.

The Holden race also caters for allcomers, from the series-model X2's of Herb Taylor and Mick Savva to the hull-house 179's of Weldon, Smith and Wilkinson, and the FX-FJ circus, the old faithfuls, represented by Barrow, Rossbridge, Lindsay and Co.

The Racing cars include some real class stuff. Two Lotus 27's, with twin-cam Ford engines, head the line-up, driven by Les Howard and Queenslander Glyn Scott. The volatile temperament of Les Howard and the cool cagey experience of Glyn Scott will make an interesting match!

So far we have looked at maybe twenty of the 208 cars and drivers entered for this day of racing. We have considered some of the fastest and some of the slowest, and still omitted nearly everyone.

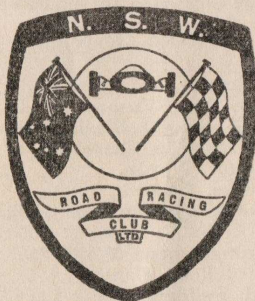

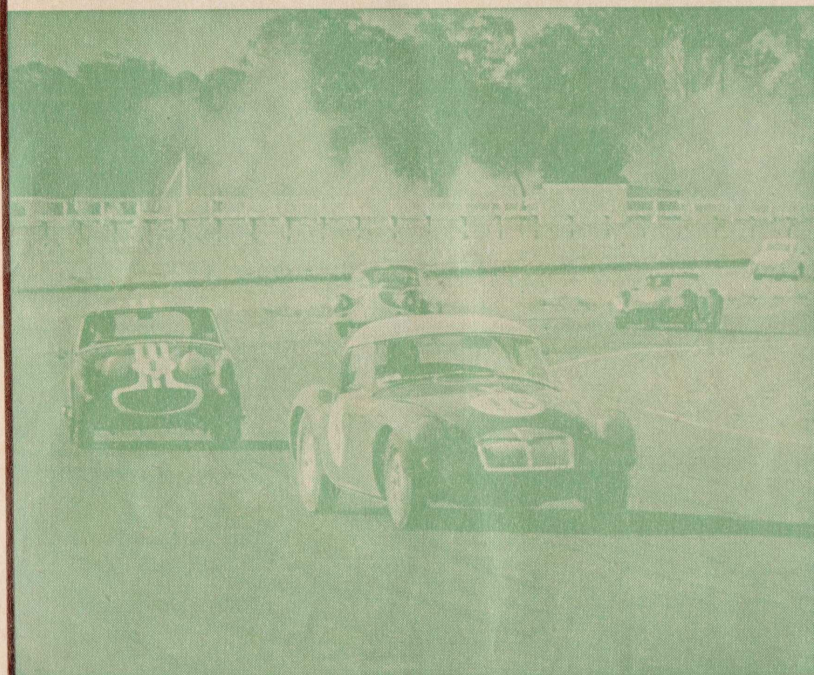
