

R.A.C. TOURIST TROPHY RACE

The most exciting cars ever to compete at Oulton Park will contest the 30th R.A.C. International Tourist Trophy Race at the picturesque Cheshire parkland circuit on Saturday, 1st May.

This historic event, the oldest motor race still being run, has produced many stirring battles in its 60 year history, but never has it brought together such an immensely powerful selection of cars as will be assembled at Oulton Park on this occasion.

The race is open to unlimited capacity sports cars and the biggest engined grand touring cars.

Mighty Lola, Lotus, McLaren-Elva, Cooper and Brabham sports cars are entering, all with vast American V.8 engines. These are the most powerful sports cars yet constructed, capable of speeds higher than ever achieved in motor racing before and well able to push the Oulton Park lap record to unprecedented heights.

Backing up the sports cars will be grand touring cars over 2,000 c.c. capacity—the ultimate in 175 m.p.h. shopping cars!—such as Ferrari G.T.O.'s and Shelby American Cobras.

The world's leading grand prix drivers are being invited to Oulton Park for the T.T. which takes on a new form this year in comprising two separate stints, each of two hours, with an interval during which the cars will be refurbished for the second half, guaranteeing full value throughout the race.
