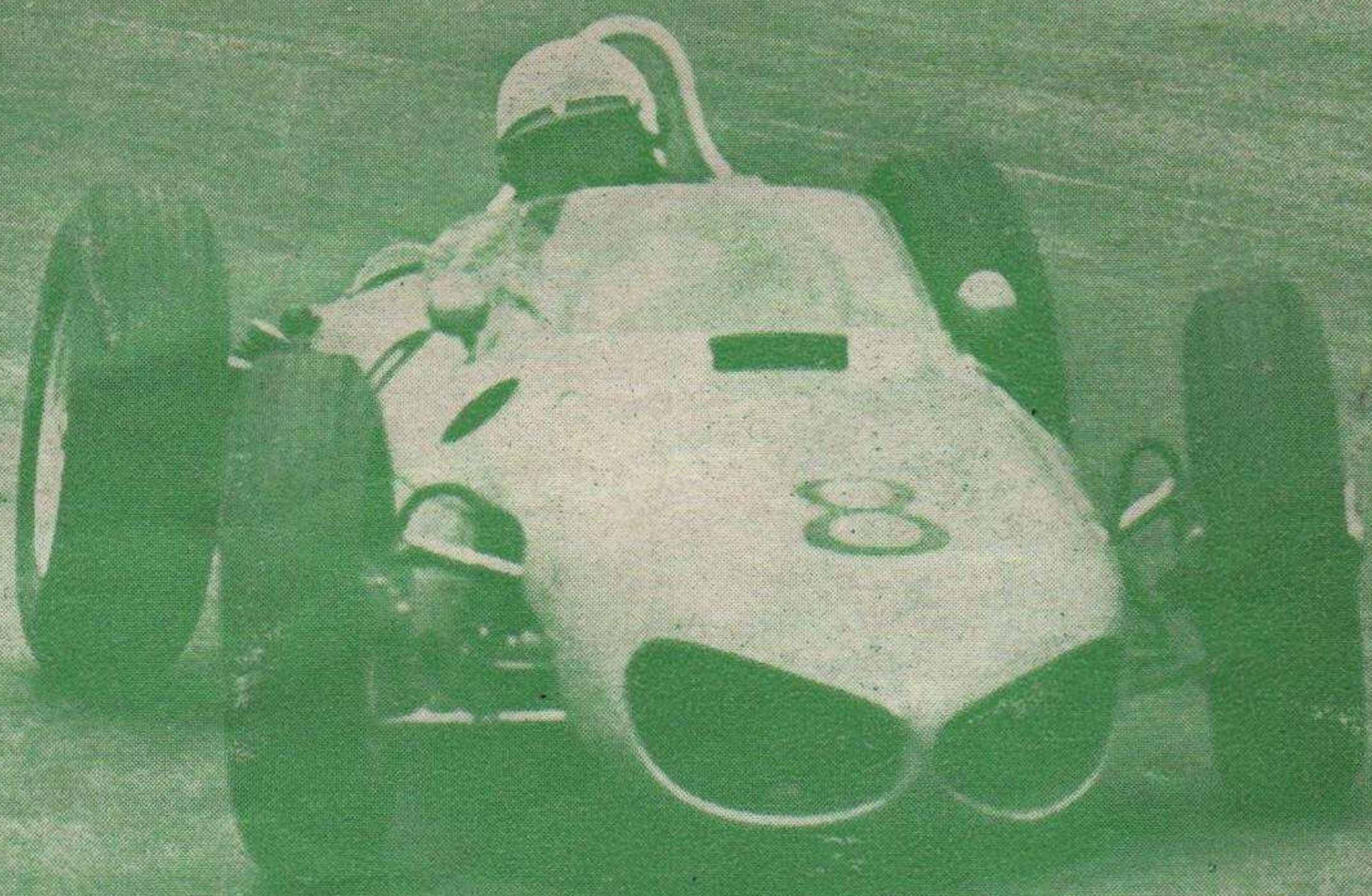

**TRAFFIC ROUTES &
ADMISSION DETAILS**

DISTRICT-BY-DISTRICT GUIDE

FROM LONDON, THE SOUTH & SOUTH-EAST

The main roads to points shown on the route maps overleaf are:

1. Edgware Road (A5) to Dunstable (all colours except Yellow).
2. Watford By-Pass (A41) to Aylesbury (all colours).
3. Western Avenue and Oxford Road (A40), then A413 to Aylesbury (all colours).

Holder of Purple labels are recommended to travel via Aylesbury and Bicester.

FROM THE MIDLANDS & THE NORTH

RED and BLUE LABELS should make for Banbury. Do NOT approach the circuit via the A5.

PURPLE and YELLOW LABELS approach via Weedon (A5) or Northampton.

BROWN LABELS via Northampton.

FROM THE WEST & SOUTH-WEST

RED, BLUE, PURPLE and YELLOW LABELS approach via Banbury, Deddington or Oxford.

BROWN LABELS—These are not normally issued to spectators travelling from the West and South-West, since an extensive detour would be entailed in order to pick up the Brown route.

FROM THE EASTERN COUNTIES

RED, BLUE, PURPLE and BROWN LABELS approach via Bedford, Dunstable or Northampton.

YELLOW LABELS approach via Northampton only.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

CAR PARKING—Although cars are parked in the enclosure corresponding with the colour of the parking label, spectators on foot may move freely all round the circuit. Actual parking spaces cannot be reserved, but car park officials will ensure that vehicles enter as swiftly as possible and are parked systematically. Overnight car parking is not possible.

PITS & PADDOCK—There are no public car parks inside the circuit. Paddock passes, price £1 each, may be obtained on the day from the kiosk at the entrance to the footbridge crossing the track.

CATERING—There are adequate catering tents with licensed bars and kiosks in all enclosures.

PRACTISING—Practising will be on Thursday afternoon, May 10th, and the morning and afternoon of Friday, May 11th. The admission charge is 2/6d. per person: car parking 2/6d. These are not bookable in advance.

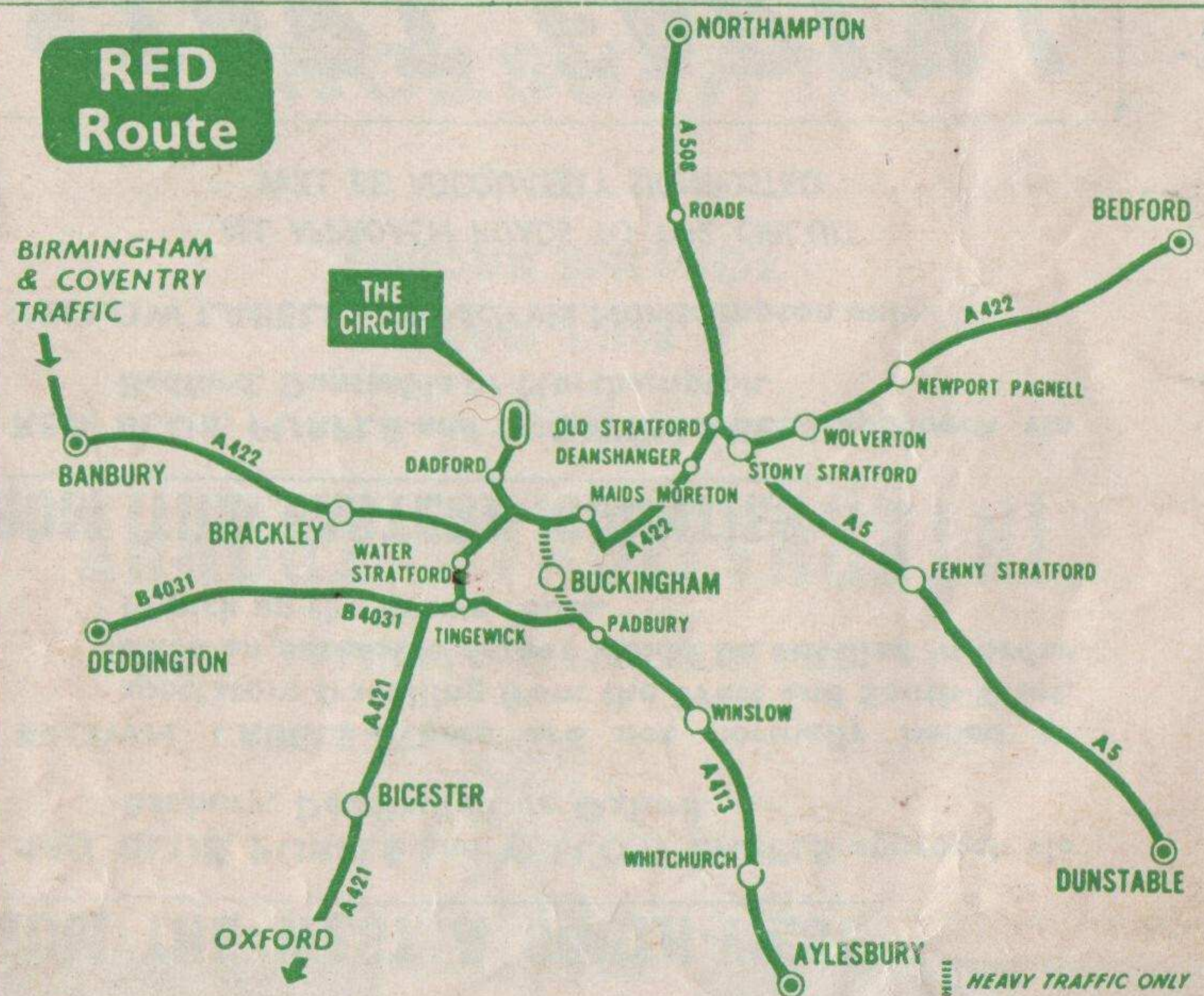
MOTOR CYCLES—There is no "all in" charge for motor-cycles. Parking labels, price 2/6d., may be obtained from the B.R.D.C. Trophy Office, but the individual admission charge of 7/6d. per person is payable at the circuit entrance.

PETROL—For the convenience of spectators, petrol filling stations will be installed in the Yellow & Red Enclosures.

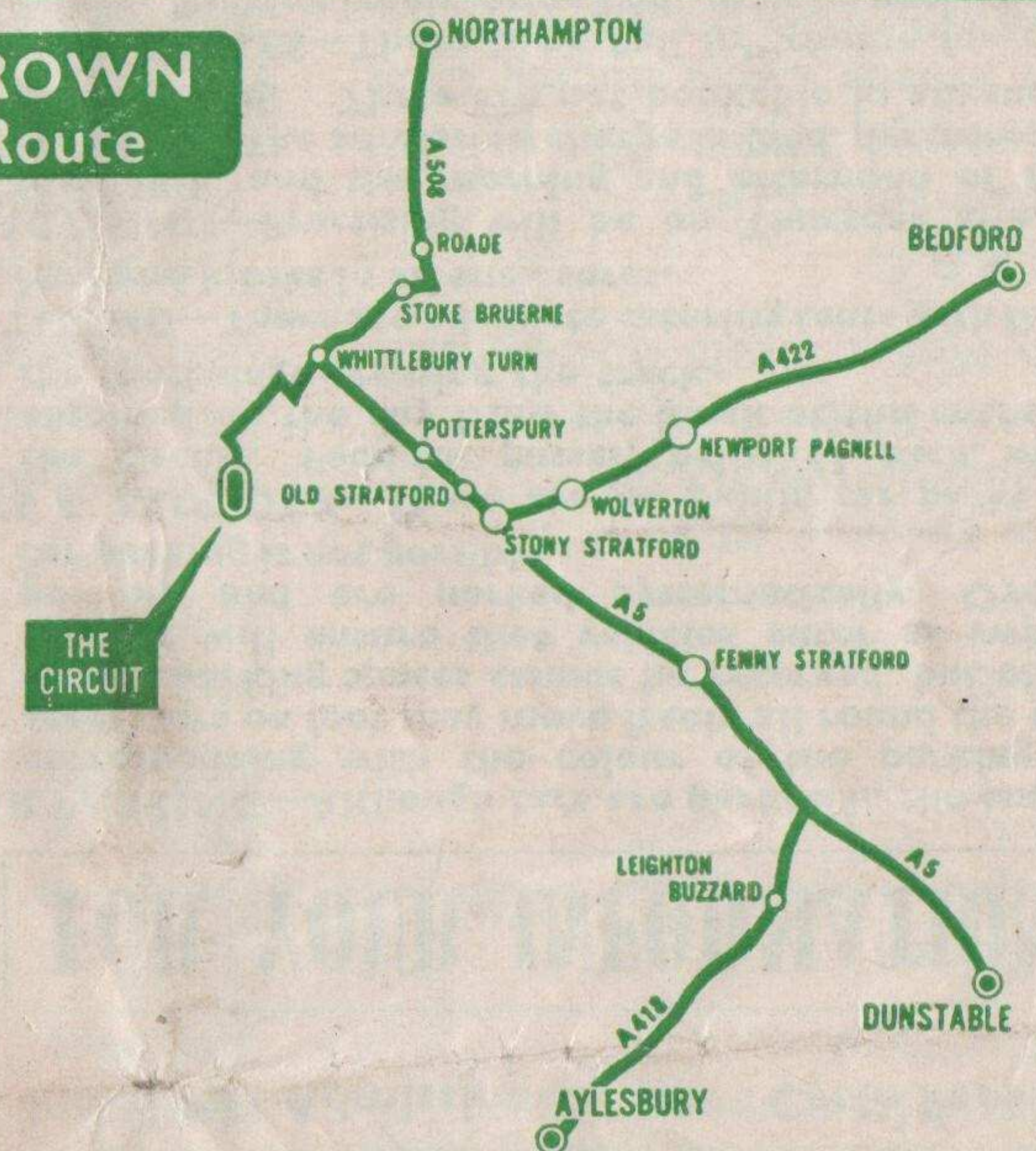

CAR ROUTES TO THE ENCLOSURES

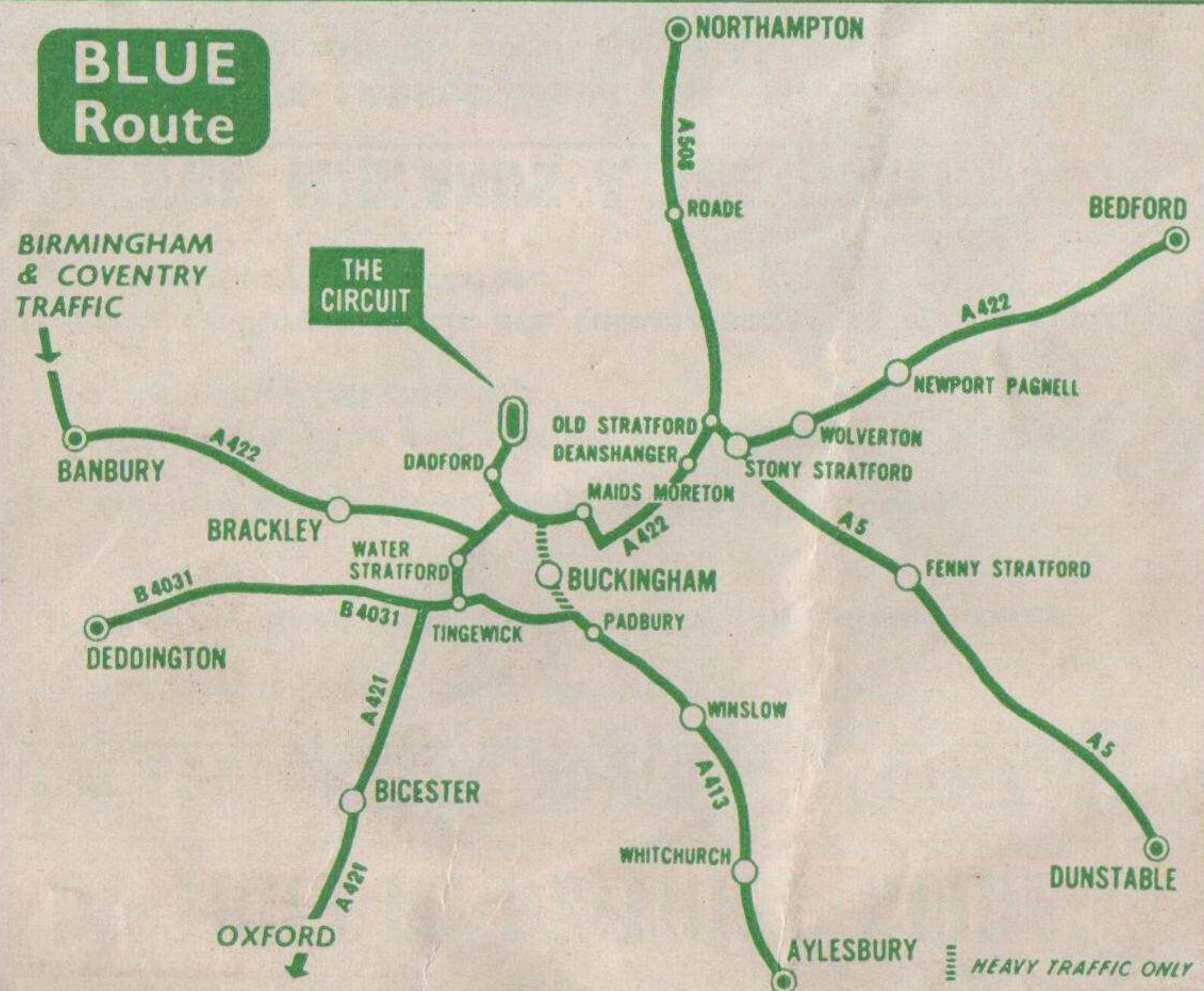
RED Route



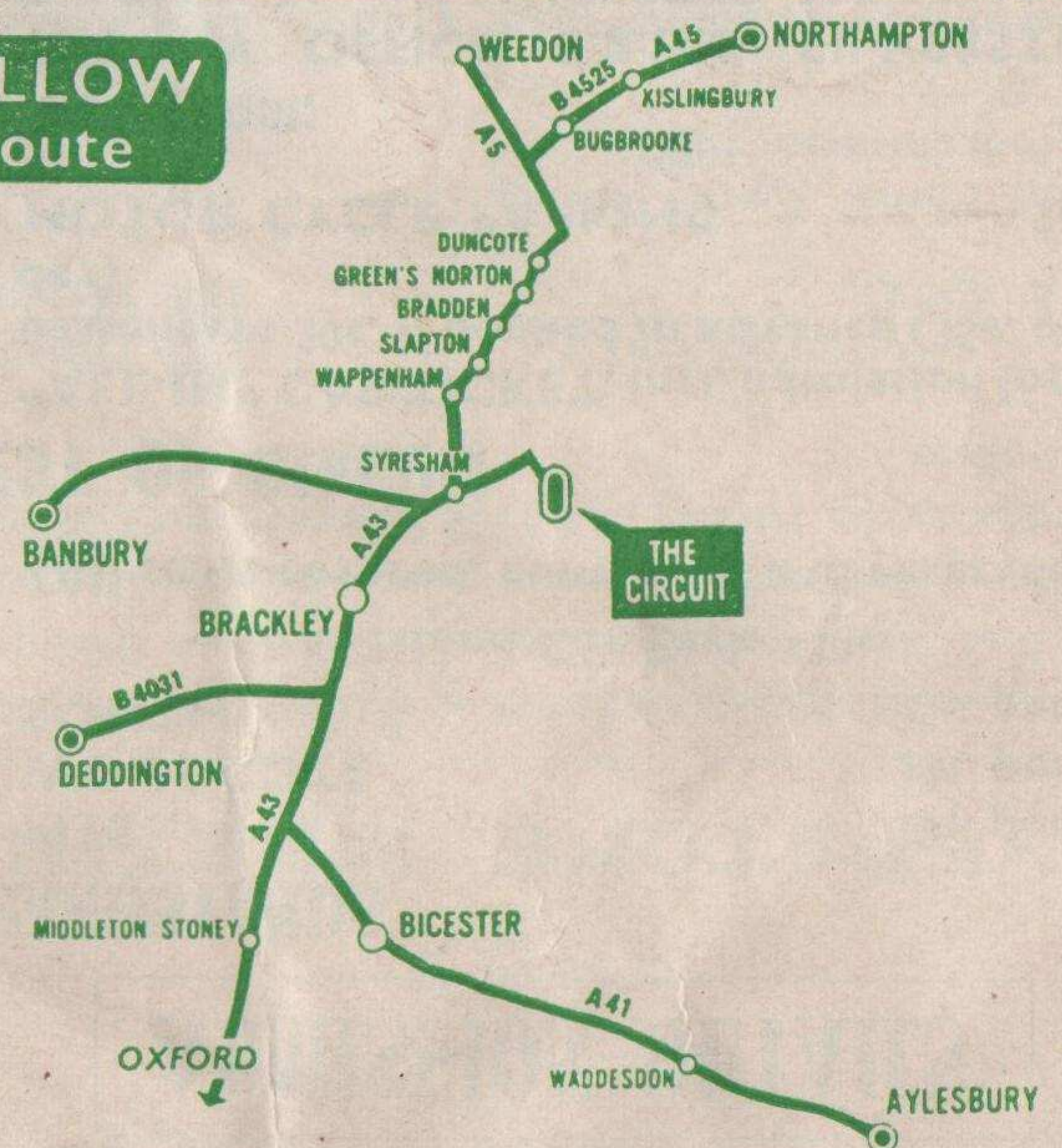
BROWN Route

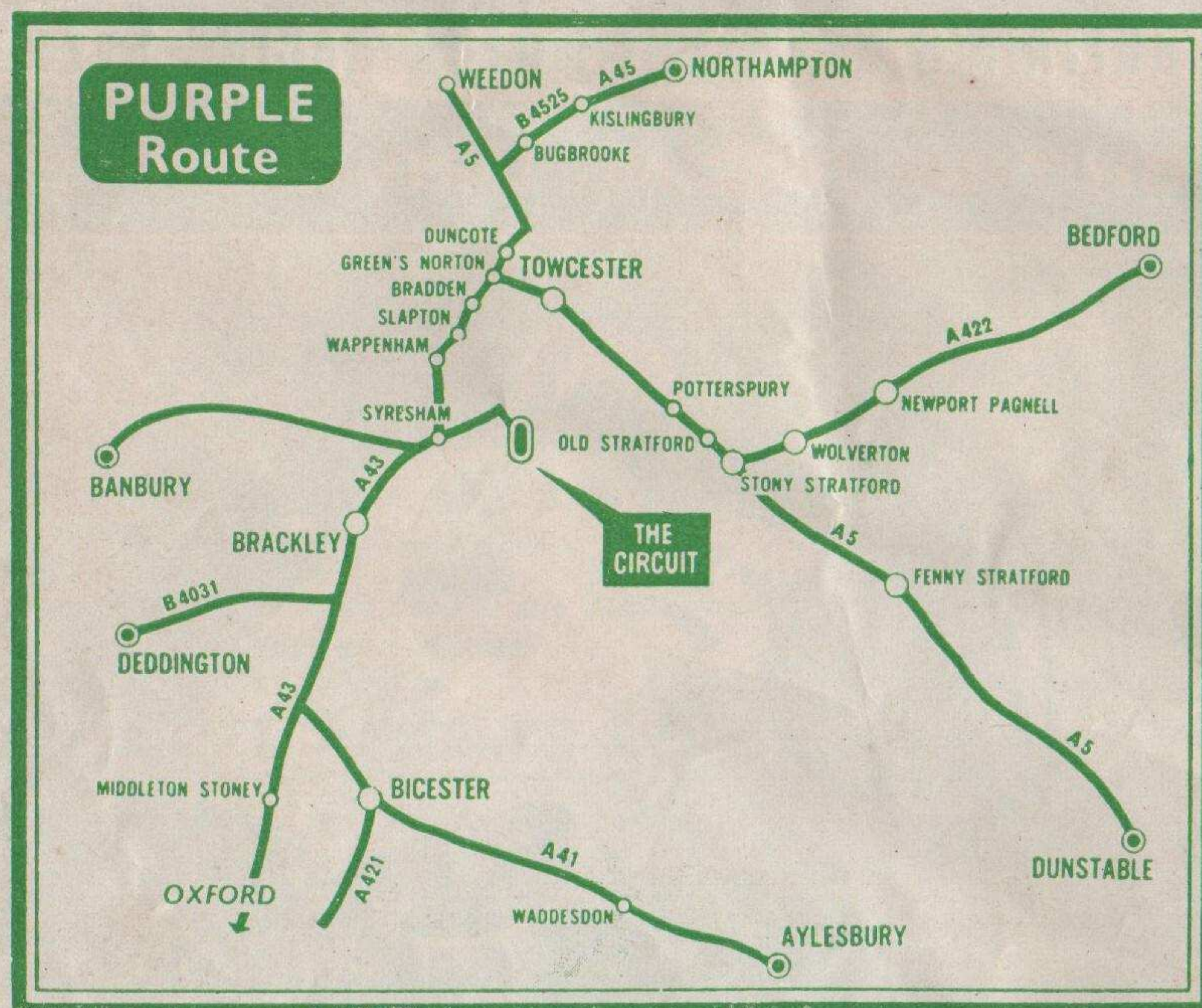


BLUE Route



YELLOW Route





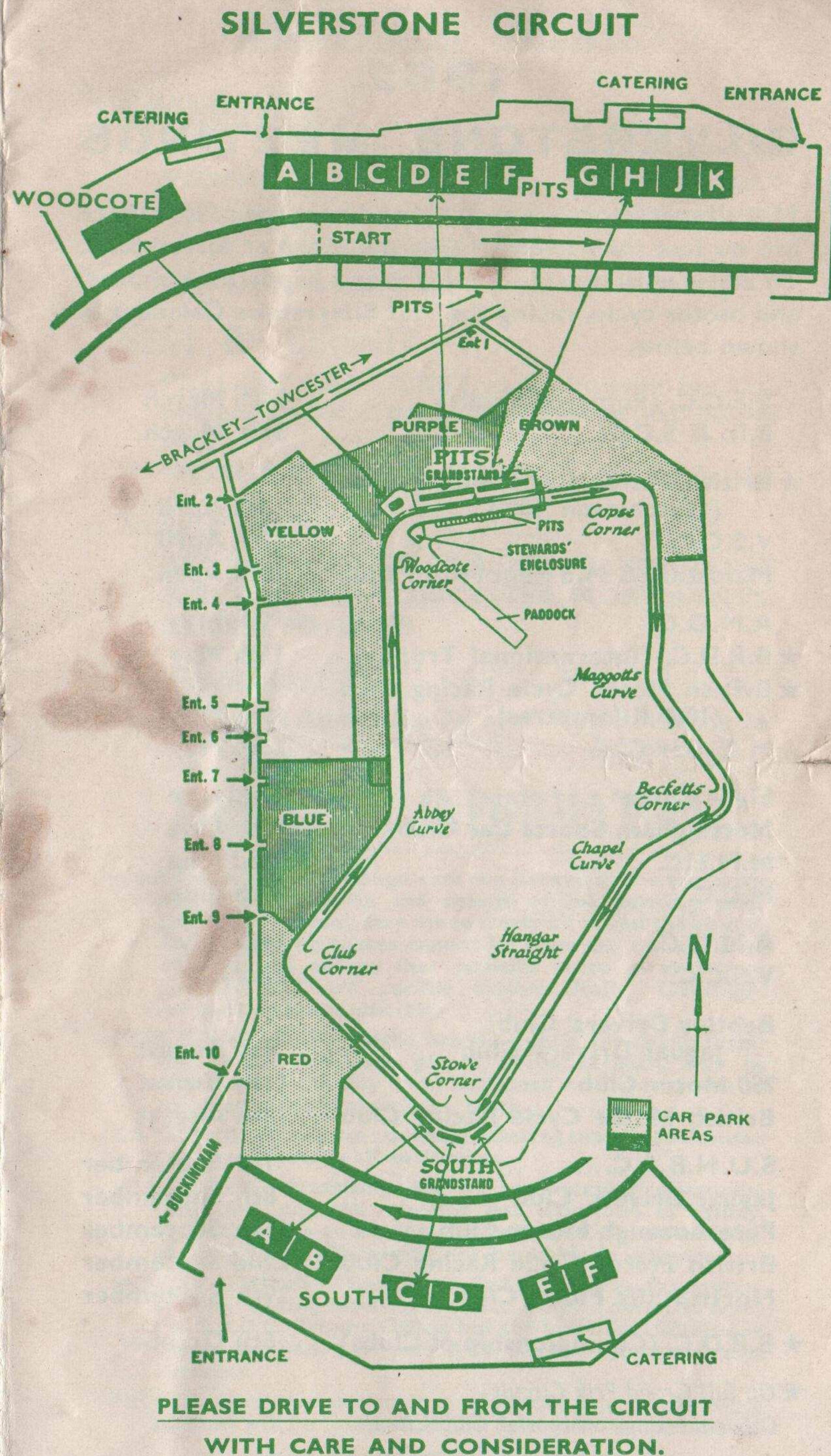
