


Book Now for Britain's Fastest Sports Car Race

The MARTINI INTERNATIONAL SUPER SPORTS will bring to Britain the world's fastest sports cars in this country's only round of the 1973 Interserie Championship. Heading the entry are the fantastic turbocharged Porsches, capable of speeds in excess of 230 m.p.h. plus the new turbocharged McLaren and Lola. These cars have never before appeared in Britain and will provide a spectacle that no enthusiast should miss. Silverstone's ultra fast Grand Prix Circuit is certainly the only circuit in this country where these giants can show off their true paces.

Remember the sight of the big Porsches and McLarens thundering through the corners last year? Also Willie Green's fantastic drive in the Ferrari to win the rain soaked and drama filled first part. These are the sort of thrills that you will see again on 20 May.

With the cancellation of the British rounds of the 3-litre and 2-litre Championships, The Martini International Super Sports now becomes the only major international sports car race in Britain in 1973.

As well as the two 35-lappers for Interserie/Can Am cars the first Grand Prix Circuit races for Formula Atlantic and Group 1 Saloons will be well worth watching. The Formula Atlantic cars have proved themselves faster than Formula 3 on the Club Circuit and as this is a round of the Yellow Pages International Formula Atlantic Championship, lap speeds of around 120 mph are expected. The Group 1 Race, a round of the Castrol Championship, should be very exciting with these cars taking Silverstone's ultra fast corners on road tyres.

Formula Fords always provide plenty of entertainment on the Grand Prix Circuit and this round of the STP Championship is sure to draw a top class entry. The Historic races at Silverstone are always big hits with the spectators and on this day of 'big sports cars' this race will feature many of the cars of yesteryear which took the honours at Le Mans, the Targa Florio and the Mille Miglia — the magic names of sports car racing.
